Stony Lake Camper Covenant

It is important that every camper reads this document closely. He or she must agree to these rules in order to participate in the Stony Lake summer camping program. Please note the ranges of possible discipline if there are problems while the camper is at Stony.

I understand that at this camp, I am part of a Christian community. Whether I am here with my church, my family, or my friends, I understand what my words and actions affect all those with whom I am camping. For my own safety, and for the safety and care of others, I promise to abide by the following:

1. I will leave all alcohol, drugs, or tobacco at home.
2. Bullying, fighting, use of weapons, fireworks, lighters, or explosive materials of any kind will not be tolerated at Stony Lake Camp.
3. I will respect and honor others and myself by not engaging in inappropriate sexual conduct, including both physical and verbal misconduct.
4. I will wear proper and inoffensive clothing and I will be tasteful in selecting swimwear for camp. (string bikinis are inappropriate]
5. I will refrain from using abusive or deliberately hurtful language.
6. I will refrain from vandalizing or stealing any property. I will keep my hands off other people’s stuff unless I have permission.
7. I will respect the opposite gender’s privacy and will refrain from going in or being near their sleeping quarters or bathing facilities.
8. I will act in a manner that will avoid injury to others or myself. I will follow camp rules which are created for my safety and the safety of those around me.
9. I will keep litter or abuse of nature from camp property.
10. I will keep food and drinks in authorized areas only. Camper food and drinks (except water) should be kept in the canteen.
11. I will be open to new experiences, and I will try new things, maintaining an attitude of cooperation and encouragement.
12. I will respect others by being on time to activities.
13. I will respect and obey the camp staff and adult leaders in charge.
14. I will respect and care for others as sister and brothers in Christ.

I understand that failure to abide by this covenant may result in my being disciplined in a manner deemed appropriate by the director, counselors, adults, and leaders of the camp, which may range from related community service to being sent home at the expense of my parent(s) or guardian(s).
