Living Water Ministries Ropes Director Job Description

General Responsibilities: Provide direction, and oversight for the high ropes staff of Stony Lake. Provide oversight, direction, and shared vision for the development and implementation of the Stony Lake ropes courses.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate will be over the age of 21, have high ropes certification, and at least 2 years ropes experience. The qualified candidate will enthusiastically embrace and live out the mission and vision of Living Water Ministries through their work and life at Stony Lake.

Reporting functions:

This position reports directly to the Program Director.

Specific Responsibilities: All responsibilities are in conjunction with the Program Director and consistent with the Mission, Vision, Core Value, Goals and policies of Stony Lake and Living Water Ministries.

- Implement the mission, purpose, goals, and objectives specific to the Ropes Courses, Ropes Staff, and campers of Stony Lake summer camp.
- Maintain a lifestyle and leadership style that exemplifies the ministry of Jesus Christ.
- Run the Stony Lake ropes courses according to procedures and policies of Living Water Ministries and Experiential Systems.
- Set up ropes course area.
- Teach staff their responsibilities in ropes activities during staff training.
- Teach and monitor proper use of ropes equipment
- Conduct daily check of area and equipment for safety, cleanliness and good repair.
- Schedule ropes duties in consort with Program Director and in a manner that provides camper safety, meets ACA, State licensing, and industry standards.
- Complete all ropes check lists and logs daily, weekly or as needed.
- Meet bi-weekly with ropes staff to evaluate ropes procedures.
- Meet with other leadership team members to coordinate ropes activities and evaluate ropes staff.

- Supervise the packing of all supplies and materials relevant to ropes courses at the end of the summer season.
- Supervise the camps ropes activities and programs.
- Write any missing procedure pieces as required by the Living Water Ministries Staff Manual.
- Complete additional tasks or assignments as requested by the Program Director or Program Innovator.

Essential Functions:

- Live up to 12 weeks at Stony Lake.
- Keep vision and direction of Stony Lake Ropes Courses, ropes staff and campers in alignment with the vision of Living Water Ministries.
- Through daily devotion, weekly worships, and frequent study and prayer with other Living Water Ministries, Synod, and Diocesan Staff, seek to remain Christ and Camper centered
